Calendar Year for LFR National Chapter Dues

In accordance with Latham Family Reunion by-laws, we are notifying you of the change in payment of the Latham Family Reunion National Chapter (LFRNC) Dues from a Fiscal Year (July - June) to a Calendar Year (January - December), effective Jan. 2013.

The Latham Family will adopt the standard calendar year convention of 12 consecutive months for payment of National Chapter Dues, which are ten dollars (\$10.00) a month.

The 24-month period for the **2015 Latham** Family Reunion runs from January 2013 - December 2013 through January 2014 - December 2014.

In accordance with our by-laws, a member (one person) in good standing for 2 years, 100% of the upcoming reunion registration fee shall be paid by the National Chapter; a member in good standing for 1 year, 50% of the upcoming reunion registration fee shall be paid by the National Chapter. The reunion registration fee will be mailed directly to the National Chapter member in January 2015 and not to the Host Chapter as payment for the reunion registration fee.
