As Elections Draw Near in 2013...

The **President** shall preside at all meetings; be the chief executive & enforce all rules/policies of the national chapter; & oversee all transactions of the national chapter. The Vice-**President** shall perform the duties of the President in their absence; & perform other duties as may be required. The **Secretary** shall be required to keep records of all proceedings; keep & read the minutes of membership at each meeting; call roll & keep a roster of all members; responsible for updating addresses, phone numbers & e-mail addresses; & perform other duties as may be required. The Treasurer shall keep records of all financial transactions of the national chapter; provide copies of the itemized statements of all financial transactions to the members at each meeting; establish an account in a recognized banking institution in the name of Latham Family Reunion with the signatures of at least three (3) family members & requiring two (2) signatures for withdrawals; shall keep an accurate account of all deposits, donations, receipts and disbursements; issue all disbursements with Latham Family Reunion checks; mail bank statements directly to the President; & perform other duties as may be required. The Family Historian shall provide new members with a copy of the by-laws; keep records of all past, present & future family members; be in charge of the family scrap book & pictures; be responsible for keeping the family history current; & perform other duties as may be required. The Sergeant-at-Arms shall maintain order during meetings & other national chapter functions; keep count of the votes.
